Can you use real objects on your maths mission ?

Mission Maths 1

Measure the perimeter of two books carefully
Can you find other two objects which have perimeters between 80 and 120 cm?

Tip: Choose objects with straight sides



Mission Maths 2

Can you find some prices on some objects?

Write the prices in pennies and in pounds and pennies.

£4.25 = 425p



Mission Maths Tips to remember:

Perimeter is the distance around the edge.

1m = 100cm

0.25m = 25cm

0.5m = 50cm

£1 = 100p

£1.30 = 130p

Mission Maths 3

Find three items which are shorter than 0.25m.
Measure them and put the measurements in cm and metres



Mission Maths 4

Find some coins.
Add the totals and show the totals in pounds and in pennies.
